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SENATOR COORDSEN: Yes, oh, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, now we're...

SENATOR COORDSEN: I was looking at Section 4.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...kind of getting together.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Pardon me, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, now if you drop to lines 24 and 25.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Um-hmm.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I am going to read the language and then ask the question; an on-site directly connected parking facility for the use of the convention and meeting center facility. Was it the committee's intent that that parking lot be restric...that parking facility be restricted in its use to a convention and meeting center facility and its activities?

SENATOR COORDSEN: The answer, Senator Chambers, I believe that this is green copy language and this was language that the Revenue Committee was not very concerned about, so I would think that there was no...no conversation as to restricting the parking facility only to the use of the convention,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But as it's...oh.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...that it might well be available for public use at another time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: As written, though, it is restricted to that purpose, wouldn't you agree?

SENATOR COORDSEN: I would agree that as written, arguably, quickly, it would say for the use of.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And if they wanted some other use, it wouldn't be too difficult to put a word or two to make it clear that that is not the exclusive use...
