50 percent of the participants are registered from a location outside Nebraska". The way it is without this amendment, it may be interpreted as meaning it has to be exactly 51...or 50 percent, so that either 49 or 51 wouldn't qualify, and that's clearly not the intent. So this would just simply made it clear that if you have 50 percent or more participants from outside Nebraska, the convention would qualify. So any questions I'd be happy to address but I would urge your support of this amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Senator Crosby, you're recognized to speak to the Raikes amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Madam President. I'm not speaking to the amendments at all. I don't feel, and I don't know how others feel, I don't know where you're divided. It was not really made clear when you said, okay, FA227. I don't know where you divided, how it was divided. I'd just like to know how it was divided.

CLERK: Senator, on page 2,...

SENATOR CROSBY: Yeah, okay.

CLERK: ...lines 20 and 21 were separated out and that is FA228.

SENATOR CROSBY: That's...that's the lines.

CLERK: Those are the second piece.

SENATOR CROSBY: Just those two lines. You see, the way it was stated, thank you, Mr. Clerk, the way it was stated, that wasn't quite clear.

CLERK: Okay, so the rest of the amendment is FA227 with the exception of those two lines.

SENATOR CROSBY: Okay, thank you. Thank you very much.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Crosby. Senator Landis, you're recognized on the Raikes amendment.
