SENATOR LANDIS: I think Senator Raikes has said more accurately what the intent was. I would accept the amendment and I think it's consistent with the introducers' goals here, and I would ask for adoption of the Raikes amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you. Seeing no further lights, Senator Raikes, would you care to close on your amendment? Senator Raikes waives. The question is the adoption of the Raikes amendment to the Landis amendment. All in favor say aye, all opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Raikes amendment to the Landis amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The Raikes amendment is adopted. We are back to the discussion of the Landis amendment which is FA227. Now we have another amendment to that.

CLERK: Senator Raikes would move to amend this amendment, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Raikes, did you wish to open on your amendment.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Madam President, and members. This is another clarifying amendment, amendment to clarify the language a little bit. On page 7, line 20, it...we add the words so that it reads "upon the annual certification under Section 9 of this act, the State Treasurer shall transfer after the audit the amount certified to the Convention Center Support Fund. Again, I think, two things, this is consistent with what the committee and the sponsor intended with the bill, and it's also consistent with Senator Landis's amendment which on page or line 6 of that same page adds the word "annually" after "shall". So we just want to make it clear that there will be an annual certification and audit and that the transfer of funds will occur after that audit has been completed. So, again, I think it simply clarifies the language and I would urge your support. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Senator Landis, your light is next.
