Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, I believe you have another amendment on the desk.

CLERK: Senator Raikes would move to amend. (AM1843, Legislative Journal pages 2169-2170.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Raikes, do you wish to open on your amendment?

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Madam President, members. We'll try this again. I'll press your patience just a little bit. On page 7, line 20 again, without this amendment the language is "Upon certification under Section 9 of this act, the State Treasurer shall transfer the amount certified to the Convention Center Support Fund". We wanted to make it clear that there is going to be an annual certification, and that funds would be transferred only after the audit. So, with the new language, it reads, "Upon the annual certification under Section 9 the State Treasurer shall transfer after the audit the amount certified". So, that's the amendment, I urge your support. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: We are now to discussion on the Raikes amendment. Seeing no lights, Senator Raikes, do you wish to close? Senator Raikes waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM1843 to LB 382. All in favor vote aye, all opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Raikes' amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The amendment is adopted. We are now on discussion of the bill and advancement to E & R. Senator Tyson, you are recognized.

SENATOR TYSON: There's a quotation, and I'm probably going to get it wrong, it says the tumult and the shouting dies, the captains and the kings depart. This bill will probably now pass. There may be only one vote against it, it will be mine, because this is a bad bill that establishes a bad precedent and allows the city of Omaha to reach into the sales tax pocket of
