PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the eighty-third day of the Ninety-Sixth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain this morning is Pastor Albert L. Winseman of the St. Mark's United Methodist Church, here in Lincoln. Pastor.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you for joining us this morning, Pastor. Members, we'll call to order. Would you please record your presence. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Do you have any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Just two items, Mr. President. LR 105 and LR 127 are ready for your signature. And that's all that I have this morning.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Members, while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 105 and LR 127. Mr. Clerk, General File, appropriation bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 556A, a bill introduced by Senator Kristensen. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, you're recognized to open on LB 556A.
