LB 87A, 267, 822, 863, 865, 881

Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. Pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8, the question is, shall LB 267 be considered for a vote without an at-large reading? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to dispense with Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is agreed to. Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

CLERK: (Read LB 267 by title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2188.) 43 ayes, 4 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Members, while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 822, LB 87A, and LB 267. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 863 and LB 865 to Select File, both with enrollment and review amendments attached. (AM7152 and AM7151, Legislative Journal pages 2188-2189.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, LB 881.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 881 was a bill originally introduced by Senator Kristensen at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on February 1 of this year, at that time was referred to the Revenue Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments
