Governor's Office has been very cooperative. They have given their word that they are going to have public announcements and will do press conferences and make it very clear that...of what's happening to the community colleges when that phenomenon occurs. We're going to work with the property tax administrator, because I think there is some form or fashion that we can put a statement into the property tax statement without doing all the computer changes. There's been an accommodation made there, and I acknowledge that and I appreciate that, that that can do and accomplish the same thing to explain to people. But it has really been the community colleges who took the lead when we did the levy limitations, came in and quite frankly, because of their formula, were able to do this today. So I'm going to leave the amendment a little bit. Senator Wickersham, I would hope that you'd make some references to that and your understanding. If there's anything else that we need to do, certainly we'll be glad to do it. While I have just a minute left, and I understand that there are a number of other people who want to talk, and I'd like to hear their input to this, but it...it does become part of another piece. There are other pieces here that we're going to talk about today that are going to show up on your property tax statement that I think we need to examine what that property tax statement is going to look like, and what changes will occur, because in two years, when all this happens, everyone is going to go, well why did that happen? And that doesn't look quite right to me. I hope that we have that discussion. Thank you, Mr. President.
