SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Did you want me to respond, or Senator Beutler to respond?

SENATOR BROMM: I don't care. Senator Beutler, would you want to respond to that?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes. Senator, the definition of...the use of the word "compliant", or the phrase "compliant livestock operation" I think appeared only in one or maybe two other places in the bill, from which it's been removed. But the language of other sections of the bills...of the bill was changed so that that language was never used elsewhere in the bill. And once...so once those paragraphs were changed, the definition was deleted, because it was...it served no useful purpose. But I don't believe, if you read through the bill, that there was any change, certainly no intent to change, and I don't believe...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time.
