approved by Game and Parks, it's been scrutinized by the Natural Resources Committee. And it's something that we have studied. We had an interim study on it. And there was a bill introduced on this issue last year. Some of the fine increases, poaching would carry a minimum...a mandatory minimum fine of \$75. It changes the ability of the commission to charge up to \$5 for a replacement permit if you lose your fishing permit or your hunting permit. So there's a lot of little details in here. It is not a new issue. It's one that's been around. And with that, I will close on my introduction to this amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the opening. Debate on the Schrock amendment? Senator Schrock, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Schrock amendment to LB 176. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I would rather not do this, if somebody would show up. I am a patient person. There we go.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted. Next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Tyson. Senator Tyson, I have AM1293, Senator. (AM1293, Legislative Journal page 1532.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Tyson, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR TYSON: If you'll bear with me for me to get organized here. Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. AM1293 relates to a recreational item, the Cowboy Trail, and the fencing of that. If you can look at the...your gizmo, you will see that what it does, it requires that the Game and Parks Commission provide the fencing on both sides of the trail where the trail dissects, or divides, an individual's property. Where only one side of the trail need to be fenced, where the other side is the highway, the Game and Parks Commission will provide
