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other agreement between adjoining landowners. It is not intended to keep cattle in. It is not intended to keep horses in. It is intended to keep people from trespassing onto the property that adjoins the trail, and to provide a measure of protection for those people who adjoin the trail and through no action of their own has been...have been pulled into a different type of liability situation from having private property adjoining them on the other side of the fence, to public property adjoining them on the other side of the fence. Now, it is true, before someone else mentions it, that wildlife habitats may be fenced with the legal fence, and this is how most...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...wildlife habitats are fenced. But they are not narrow corridors. They are not generally restricted to people...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...walking on a path between one fence and the road or between two fences, with lots of good-looking stuff to investigate...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time, Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...on the other side of the boundaries. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Tyson, the Chair has been reviewing the Schrock amendment. It's a lengthy amendment. I was in error. At this point, I'm going to go back and tell you that I have found a section that did open up the same article and the same chapter of which your amendment is. With that, I will rule that that amendment was germane. If you would like to remove your motion to suspend the rules, I'll do it, and tell you that I think it was my error and I want to correct it at this point.

SENATOR TYSON: Not only will I remove it, Mr. Speaker; I will also call to the attention of the body that prayer does have power. Thank you very much.
