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everything. So with that, I guess I'll just listen and see what the body decides. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. From reading the fiscal note, you can see that even though we'll have volunteer instructors, there will be costs associated with implementing and maintaining the licensing program. Contracts with individuals...the fiscal note says initially the commission predicts having to contract with individuals to serve as instructors since the number of volunteer instructors would not be sufficient to train the number of students they envision. The cost of such contracts would be \$97,500 the first year, and \$18,750 the second. One full-time water safety officer will be responsible for coordinating. Total cost for this position should be \$101,000 first year, \$50,000 the second. Part-time clerical, \$10,500. There's plenty of costs even though you have volunteer instructors, and I...I guess...I guess I consider...I consider this bill to be very, very important and I'll go with it either way as well. I did speak with Game and Parks and they reaffirmed that they're not opposed to this amendment. I think at first they were concerned about how they would work with it, but my understanding is now their plan would be to send a...have the volunteer instructor give the student, once they've completed the course, a form which they would sign and then he'd send in to Game and Parks with the ten bucks. Game and Parks would handle the money and send him the certificate. So it's not like volunteers are going to be handling money, and Game and Parks told me they would not oppose the amendment. So I just...I mean, I'll live with the body. I'm not going to take this to the wall at all, but I think it's a reasonable fee for providing a service that's very...very important. And again, I think some people take ownership in something they pay a few dollars for. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Hilgert.

SENATOR HILGERT: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. I just wanted to clarify a comment that I made. I expressed some of the concerns and some of the talk that we had regarding this, but I do want to reaffirm what Senator Bromm said. The Game and
