believe that Senator Schrock had showed me the brochure that talked about, from the jet skis, the potential of going 85 miles an hour. Of course, it has something to do with your body weight, Senator Tyson... (laughter)...and some people are going to go slower and some are going to go faster. And I would assume that a lot of 14-year-olds would go a lot faster than Senator Tyson. (Laughter) And so I do think that, taking that into account, it is very likely that those youngsters would be on a jet ski that would travel much faster and that was the reason for the discussion. And as I've said, certainly on the federal level, they're looking at banning them altogether. And so we certainly haven't gone that far but I think we're just asking to be reasonable and we do it with other vehicles, as I've stated before. We say that our children have to now have some preparation before they have a driver's license. It makes little sense that we're going to turn them loose with something that has the potential of going as fast, if not faster, and have no requirements. At least automobiles have brakes. So I do think that this is a reasonable bill and the amendment simply restricts it to the jet skis. So I ask for your support of the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: We are on the Bohlke amendment. Discussion?

SENATOR SCHMITT: Yes, Madam President. I guess, even with Senator Bohlke's amendment, now I am going to rise to support this. The question I had before was when Senator Smith talked about the jet ski being in regulation for 14 years to operate a motor boat, I was wondering whether they classified that as a motorboat. But I have a friend and last week when we talked about this, I believe I had mentioned that I thought it was Kawasaki that had the 200 horse in it. I believe I was wrong on that. I was over at the lake last weekend and he had it in the water and I believe it's a Yamaha. But according to him, it's got 200 horses in it, and I think it would probably pull I and Senator Tyson both at 85 mile an hour if we had nerve enough to ride it. I don't think I would ride it that fast, but I think it would run that fast. Yeah, we could even throw Janssen on there, I think. There's room for three of us. It's a pretty good-sized craft. (Laugh) But I think 16 is young enough. Would we legalize 14-year-olds to ride motorcycles? It's
