SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you. Senators Preister and Lynch, would you please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. Mr. Clerk, would you call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 2228-2229.) 23 ayes, 18 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The amendment is not adopted. Mr. Clerk, do you have another amendment on the desk? The house...the call is raised.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Hilgert. Senator, FA17...I am sorry, FA238. (FA238, Legislative Journal page 2229.)
