CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of the appointment of Mr. Lewis.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is successful. Senator Suttle.

SENATOR SUTTLE: The second one is a lady from Scottsbluff. Her name is Willa Kosman. She is a graduate of the Western Nebraska Community College in Scottsbluff, as well as Chadron State College, so she is well qualified with a good postsecondary knowledge of the State College System. I urge you to support Willa Kosman.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Discussion on the confirmation report of Ms. Kosman? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this nomination gives me the opportunity to swing from villain to gentleman. I'm supporting this nomination, and I'm pleased that I have the opportunity to vote aye this morning.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Suttle, you're recognized to close. Senator Suttle waives closing. The question before you is the adoption of the Education Committee confirmation report, found on Journal page 2156, of Ms. Kosman. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay.
