CLERK: Mr. President, the first A bill this morning, LB 865A, introduced by Senator Dwite Pedersen. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Pedersen, recognized to open on LB 865A.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature. (LB) 865A, obviously, just follows 865, which was a bill that we advanced last week, and it'll be coming up later today on Select File, that creates a task force to evaluate substance abuse treatment services in the adult and juvenile criminal justice systems. The amount of this A bill is \$60,000, which to some would be peanuts, but I believe that it's a decent hunk of money that...but we would like to have this follow along, and if at all possible, have it go with the bill. And I would hope that you would support it at this stage. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. Discussion on the advancement of LB 865A? Senator Pedersen, you're recognized to close. Senator Pedersen waives closing. The question is the advancement of LB 865A to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 865(A) is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 637A was introduced by Senator Brown. (Read title.)
