SENATOR TYSON: Mr. President, I ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unexcused senators please report to the Chamber. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor.

SENATOR TYSON: (Microphone not activated immediately.) ...for a roll call vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a roll call vote. Senator Baker, Senator Bohlke, Senator Bourne, please. Senator Crosby, would you please check in. Senator Price, please check in. House is under call. All unexcused senators please check in. Senator Stuhr and Senator Wickersham. Senator Dickey, please check in. Okay. Senator Brown.

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. President, could we have that in...roll call in regular order, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The roll call in...Senator Stuhr. Senator Tyson, did you say to go ahead? Mr. Clerk.
