SENATOR BROWN: ...and...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Then...then why do we need these new sections?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler and Senator Brown. Senator Tyson, did you wish to close on your amendment? There are no further lights.

SENATOR TYSON: I'll waive, but I will ask for a call of the house and a machine...pardon me, a roll call in reverse order.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unexcused senators please check in. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. The house is under call. Senators, please check in. Senator Bourne, Senator Dwite Pedersen. Senator Suttle, Senator Thompson. Senator Chambers and Senator Engel, please check in. The house is under call. Senators, the house is under call. Please check in, if you have not. Senator Thompson and Senator Suttle. Senator Engel, please check in. Senator Tyson, there are two who haven't checked in yet. Did you wish to...Senator Tyson said to proceed in reverse order and a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2253-2254 of the Legislative Journal.) 3 ayes, 27 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment to...FA245 is not adopted. Raise the call, please. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to Senator Tyson's FA245, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We are back on amendment 245, which is part two of the divided question to LB 105. Seeing no further lights, Senator Tyson, do you wish to close?
