SENATOR VRTISKA: It says "constructed or acquired".

SENATOR SCHIMEK: "After the operative date of this act". Then who would be acquiring it? You mean, like a private developer, something like that?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Well, I'm trying to figure out if...if you had a facility that was...that you was investor in and you were grandfathered under this...under this bill and you sold it, the person who bought it would not...the grandfather rights would not go with it.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: "Constructed or acquired after the operative date of this act", yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: That's what you intend for it to do.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. Well, I just wanted to make sure that that's...that's the way I read it and I wanted to...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...make sure that's what it said, and I wanted your...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...on record to say that's what you really mean.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: That is what I really mean.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: (Laugh) Okay.
