operative on January 2, 2000. Then in order to retain the current tax exemption of the housing authority property, which becomes housing agency property on January 1, we amended the tax exempt statute, Section 71-1510 to make it apply to housing agencies property on January 1, and then repealed the statute on January 2. This amendment would also reserve the current tax exemption of Indian Housing Authority which was created under federal law. So it simply ties it into LB 270 (sic). With that, I'd answer any questions, would ask for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Discussion on adoption of Amendment 1877? Senator Hartnett, you're recognized to close. Senator Hartnett waives closing. The question is the adoption of Amendment 1877 to LB 105. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: I'm sorry.

SENATOR BEUTLER: That would work.

CLERK: Okay. Yes, sir. In that case, Senator Beutler, I would now have AM1898, which you just gave to me.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.
