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LB 105

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2262-2263 of the Legislative Journal.) 17 ayes, 18 nays on the amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is not agreed to. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hartnett would move to amend. (See FA249 on page 2263 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Hartnett, you're recognized to open on amendment, Floor Amendment 249.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Madam (sic) President, members of the body, mentioned I had earlier amendment from the State Auditor. We forgot one sentence and what it says is "a copy of each audit report shall be filed with the Auditor of Public Accounts within six months after the end of the fiscal year of each such agency." And that's all it does, it simply says that the report from each of the housing agencies will be filed with the Auditor.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. On the Senator Hartnett amendment, Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers waives. Senator Hartnett waives. Senator Hartnett, you're recognized to close. Senator Hartnett waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Hartnett amendment to LB 105. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Hartnett's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Raikes would move to amend the bill. (See FA250 on page 2263 of the Legislative Journal.)
