SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kristensen, there are no further lights. You're recognized to close if you wish.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. I will close at this point in time. I would make one observation about the Bohlke amendment. It's a typical Bohlke amendment that's got an old computer printout from probably 1900. Half those that I saw coming out of the Education Committee, you couldn't tell if they occurred in 1900 or the year 2000. With that, I do appreciate the patience of the body. This is a fairly technical area. And what I would make as an offer would be...Senator Brashear's staff has been very versed in the area. They're good. My staff would be happy to answer any questions, and we'd be glad to look at it between now and Select File. And if there's anyone else who would like to have part of my closing, I'll look around, and if anybody wants part of the closing they can have it. If not, I would urge the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing nobody...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: No takers?

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...taking up your offer...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I would urge the advancement of the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is, shall LB 661 be advanced to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye; opposed nay. We are voting on the advancement of LB 661 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 661.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 661 does advance to E & R
