Senator Bohlke waives closing. All in favor of the Amendment 1888 to the...to LB 816, vote aye; opposed nay. We are voting on the Bohlke amendment to LB 816. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Bohlke's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, anything further?

CLERK: I have nothing further on this bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 816 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye; opposed nay. It is advanced.

CLERK: Senator Smith, with respect to LB 816A, I have no amendments to that bill, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I'd move the advancement of LB 816A to E & R for engrossing.
