LB 32, 32A, 314A

SENATOR COORDSEN: I would ask (sic) the members that we are on Final Reading; if you're not excused, please return to your seat. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 32 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2333.)
45 ayes, 1 nay, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: LB 32 passes. Mr. Clerk, LB 32A.

CLERK: (Read LB 32A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2334.)
45 ayes, 1 nay, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: LB 32A passes. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Bohlke would move to return LB 314A to Select File, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Bohlke, on your motion to return.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Mr. President and members. This amendment will allow you to remove \$2,773,988 from the biennium budget. The...314, as you remember, was the hardship bill. As it was first introduced, it...schools may or may not have had to pay back the money. And so we...it was changed on the floor that it's strictly a loan program, therefore you don't need the monies in the first year, you do not need it in the second year. This removes that amount of money that was originally reflected necessary in that second year. And so I would assume that most people may wish...or, I would think they may wish to support the removal of \$2.7 million from the bill...from the budget.
