this language out of the jet ski bill. And I would also support on Select File Senator Preister attempting to amend his amendment that failed to get adopted while we were discussing the jet skis. And I appreciate Senator Beutler's willingness to do this. And hopefully everything will work out and the jet ski bill will be returned to Select File, that language stricken out. Hopefully that's all we'll do on LB 176 when we return it back to Select File, and then we'll readvance it to Final. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the committee amendments? Senator Schrock, you're recognized to close on those amendments.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Well, now, if I have this process figured out, we need to vote red on the committee amendments. Is that correct, Senator Beutler? And then we will advance the committee amendment (sic). So stay with us. If you're used to pushing your green button, let's push the red one this time. And then Senator Beutler's bill, which is not a substantive change to the committee amendments, will be offered, and that will become the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 0 ayes, 33 nays on the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The committee amendments are not adopted.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend with AM1904, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 2344-2350.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is step two in the process, which is inserting, again, no more or no less than what sits in LB 176 on Final Reading with regard to the recycling portion of that bill. So it's a simple
