because it's a little handier to get at it when it's in the minimum reserve than it is over in the Cash Reserve, in case we have a disaster in the state. So with that, I don't think I'll support this amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Jones, if I may just take one...it's certified forecast, so we were technically correct. It'd be a certified forecast which is using the Forecast Board numbers. So it's the same thing.

SENATOR JONES: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: But it is a certified number that we're operating under right now that's...last one was in April. We will not have another Forecast Board meeting till October now.

SENATOR JONES: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you. Senator Beutler. Just a second. I've been passing Senator Wickersham over. Did you still wish to speak? Okay. There are no other lights on. Senator Beutler, did you wish close on your amendment?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Coordsen, members of the Legislature, there doesn't seem to be widespread support for the amendment. At least nobody spoke for it. So I guess I shouldn't be wasting your time further. And with that, I'd withdraw the amendment.
