CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wickersham's amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The Wickersham amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Beutler, to speak to the advancement of LB 881.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Coordsen, members of the Legislature, Senator Wickersham, could I have an exchange with you to be sure that I understand, we all understand one particular portion of the bill?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: On the first page of the bill, AM7154, it describes the amount of the relief in the year 2000, this is under Section 4, Senator.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And then down on line 20, there's a sentence that says: It is the intent of the Legislature to fund the Relief to Property Taxpayers Act for tax years, and this is with Senator Chambers' amendment, it now reads,...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...the year 2001, the year 2003...2002, and the year 2003 using available excess revenues.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.
