SENATOR PREISTER: I don't believe so, but it's something we might look at.

SENATOR HILGERT: Thank you, Senator Preister.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hilgert. Further discussion on AM1905? Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature, I think Senator Preister has brought us a good amendment. If people are going to take state money for collecting tires, they should be responsible for disposing of them; they should just not be collected. So I think we have a good amendment here, and I urge the body to support the amendment, AM1905. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Just wish to indicate, Mr. President, that as sponsor of the bill I have certainly no objection to the amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Further discussion? Senator Preister, to close on AM1905 to LB 592.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President, friends all. Again, I rise to ask for your support for this amendment. As you've heard from the bill's sponsor and Senator Schrock, the Chair of the Natural Resources Committee, it's something that, if we're going to spend state monies, we should make sure that they're handled responsibly and that people obey the law when they do that. I would ask for your positive vote on this amendment, and I thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Preister. The question is the adoption of AM1905 to LB 592. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.
