Legislature. Again, the amendment changes the pay increase, this is the straight change in salary, from the November election to the May election. It cleans up some 1964 legislative elections and also does a little cleanup, but it does retain the \$2,000 per month. If I could add one other observation, given what Senator Chambers said about Senator Peterson, I'm extremely glad that he's not going to ever get the chance to give me a plaque, because I'm afraid of what he might give me when he gives me the plaque. So, with that, I would urge the adoption of the amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. The question is the adoption of AM1926 to LR 5CA. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you voted? Please record.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Kristensen's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the resolution, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LR 5CA to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LR 5CA. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill (sic) is advanced. We will proceed to Final Reading.
