SENATOR HILGERT: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I rise to make the body aware of a tragedy that happened in Omaha yesterday. The Bemis Bank Building, which is 112 years old, went up in flames, took 80 firefighters to control the blaze. Fortunately, there were no injuries. But unfortunately, Nebraskans lost a wealth of art, studios, collections and works, among them Susan Knight and Steven Roberts. I bring this to your attention because Steven Roberts' work graces our Memorial Chamber, on the top of the Capitol, and his studio was destroyed as well. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hilgert. Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members.
