PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion? Senator Vrtiska, you're recognized to close. Senator Vrtiska waives closing. The question is the adoption of the confirmation report of the Business and Labor Committee. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 2 nays on the confirmation report, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The confirmation report is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next report, by Education Committee, found on page...well, the appointments to the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education and State College Board of Trustees.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Mr. President and members. We have two individuals to present to you for approval. The first is Sheryl Lindau from Wayne, Nebraska to the Board of Trustees, the Nebraska State Colleges. She was present before the committee and has been very active in the community, and is also the Mayor of Wayne. The second is Earl Rademacher from Kearney, Nebraska to the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education. He also appeared before the committee, has a long list of activities and involvement in education, and both were well aware of the commitment and the time that they would be making, and the committee recommends them both to you for your favorable consideration.
