PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. The question is, shall the bill pass notwithstanding the objections of the Governor? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you voted? Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 2435-2436.) 32 ayes, 13 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed notwithstanding the objections of the Governor. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Kristensen would move that LB 556A become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Kristensen, on your motion to override.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This is the A bill. And quite frankly, the A bill makes Cash Fund transfers to make the license plate, the increase in that fee take place. And I don't think there's any controversy of the A bill, and I would urge the overriding.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Seeing no lights, Senator Kristensen, you're recognized to close.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I would waive closing. Thank you.
