session. We've worked very hard throughout this session. We've tackled some extremely difficult issues. The expectations as we come in to a new session sometimes are mixed and we never know what personality a Legislature may take. This Legislature's personality is a good one. Its work ethic has been unparalleled. This will go down as one of the most productive and efficient Legislatures in many, many years and you should all feel very, very proud of your service and what you've done. I mean that, absolutely every one of you. We've dealt decisively with a number of issues. We didn't put everything off. We didn't pass everything. We did the state's business and did it well. And now, for the first time in over 20 years, we're going to adjourn sine die this afternoon on the eighty-ninth day. No one disagrees that that's a good thing for the state to do. It is a good move for the state. We did the business well. Every senator's priority bill that was on General File was considered. Every committee bill, priority bill, that was on General File was considered this year. And we did all those things with civility and respect, and that's probably the thing that you can take home most feeling good about. And there are a number of years where I walk out of here and say, I'm so glad to go home, I want out of here so bad, and the last thing I want to do is think about next year. I can honestly tell you that I think each and every one of you, at least I know from my point of view, I look forward coming back and working with all of you next year. I think the state should feel the same way. Mr. President, I think it's now appropriate for us to advise the Governor that the Legislature's about to complete its work.
