PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Good morning, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the third day of the Ninety-Sixth Legislature, Second Session. Our prayer this morning is by Reverend Harland Johnson, of Lincoln, Nebraska. Harland.
