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Development Committee, or some...some phrases that were a little bit different. At that time, I thought it was a good idea simply because it might bring some more bills into Agriculture, and many of them are, in this year, you know, the buzzword is added value or value added, and it would appear to me that if some times the Exec Board could see their way to put more bills into Ag committee, which I have suggested on a number of...a number of time when I served on the Exec Board, perhaps the numbers could be evened out. I don't know that that's going to do a great deal of service to the Judiciary Committee, because so many of their...so much of their legislation points to legal matters and, as a result, I'm not sure that we can take bills out of Judiciary and put it over in Agriculture, although there could be times when it might be acceptable. But I just wanted to make the comment that on this portion of the change I would certainly support Senator Chambers moving this committee back to the number that he suggested. With that, thank you very much.
