CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 884.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 884 is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 885, Mr. President, by Senator Coordsen, as Chair of the board. (Read title.) Introduced on January 5 of this year, referred directly to General File.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Coordsen, to open on LB 885.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. LB 885 provides that...for the elimination of several sections that provided for divestment of certain property. Those divestments have been made and these sections are no longer needed. I would move for the advancement of LB 885.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. There being no lights, Senator Coordsen waives closing. Question is to advance LB 885 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.
