To do otherwise is to diminish his office and his ability to run his office and, on that basis, I would ask you to vote for this portion of the divided question. Thank you.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Senator Chambers. Senator, this is your third time on this division.

**SENATOR CHAMBERS:** Thank you. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I'm tempted to read some of the things that these...that this Judge Bartu did to these women but I'm not going to take the time for that, but I did give you all an excerpted version of the complaint. And, for Senator Tyson's information, the word "shall" appears in the Code of Professional Responsibility, which governs lawyers, and the word "shall" appears in the Code of Judicial Conduct emphasizing that this kind of conduct that judges are to engage in is mandated. Certain types of misbehavior, there is a mandate that they not engage in it, but they do anyway against women and nobody calls them to account. And here this man is back here so worried about this giant sprawling agency and saying this man's power or ability to do his job is going to be infringed when we, as a Legislature, set up a structure in such a way that it will carry out the intent that we have when we enact the legislation. If we mean something, why don't we say we mean it? And we show that we mean something in legislation by using the word "shall", not "may". If we use the word "may" there is no need to do whatever it is we're undertaking. It's nothing more than a suggestion, advice, and we are not in a position, in my opinion, this late in the game in this society to be leaving things to the discretion of a group of people, namely males, who have shown every time they had the opportunity that they're not going to do the right thing. If this is what he's going to do anyway, why is it a problem to say he shall do what he says he's going to do anyway based on what Senator Tyson is telling us? I'm not going to be offended if I go to a doctor's office and he says, Ernie, do you want to live; I say, yes, Doctor; he says, then you shall breathe, meaning I must. Thank you, Doctor, for telling me what I ought to do to stay alive. For us to see the necessity to create a program or establish a policy is saying on
