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SENATOR TYSON: Please.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the adoption of the first portion of the Tyson amendment to the Schimek amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the first portion of the Tyson amendment to the Schimek amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: First portion of the divided amendment is not adopted. I raise the call. Senator Tyson, you're recognized to open on the second portion of the divided amendment, that being line 2 and the first word in line 3. (FA263, Legislative Journal page 269.)

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. This, the second division of the question, again is a permissive: Nothing in Sections 1 through 7 of this act allows the Women's Health Initiative of Nebraska to accept any private donations that are not in keeping with the goals and objectives and set forward in the initiatives and the Department of Health and Human Services. Now, in dividing the question, we're getting away from the totality of the amendment, but that's permissible. This does not allow the Women's Health Initiative or the people within Health and Human Services to accept private donations that are not in keeping with the goals of the initiative. The goals of the initiative and the goals of the Department of Health and Human Services is something that we're yet to consider, and that would be in the third and fourth parts of the amendment, as divided. What all of this about is very, very simple. This is about the use of this bill to further the...I'm searching for the right word, I'd ask Senator Chambers but he wouldn't help me...further the goals of providing abortion services through Health and Human Services or, in the original bill, through the Women's Health Initiative. That's what this is all about. Now we can take that long, long keyboard that Senator Chambers referred to here 10-15 minutes ago. He referred to it as pussyfooting from coast to coast on that long keyboard and I think I'll refer to it as a tap dance because that's what all this is. It's a tap dance. What we're
