to the bill in this amendment, and I have to emphasize I really did try to address the major concerns that I did hear on the floor last year. For instance, we put "advisory" in to make it clear that the council that would be set up would be advisory only. We did make the executive director an ex-officio, nonvoting member of that initiative or that council because we thought that that person should be more like a staff person. We did address the abortion issue through the language on pages 4, I believe, let me see, page 5, page 5. And if you have any questions, I would be happy to address them, but I think that we...we had a good discussion and I think people understand what's in the amendment so, with that, I would simply urge the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you for that closing, Senator Schimek. The question is the adoption of the Schimek amendment to LB 480. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of Senator Schimek's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The Schimek amendment is agreed to. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is from Senator Tyson. Senator, this is AM1055. I have a note you want to withdraw this.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Tyson, AM1597, I also have a note on that one.

SENATOR TYSON: Same response, Mr. Clerk, thank you.
