SENATOR COORDSEN: I'm not...the potential material that...in the amendment here, in front of us, I'm not going to propose to put LB 1124 into this at any time this session.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Oh, okay.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Okay? This simply...

SENATOR BEUTLER: So, what was the discussion about the public hearing, or how...

SENATOR COORDSEN: Well, the point of it is this language is also in LB 1124,...

SENATOR BEUTLER: I see.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...the language with respect to farm...how you value the real estate under...

SENATOR BEUTLER: I see.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...occupied or vacant farm sites.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So,...

SENATOR COORDSEN: That is also part of LB 1124. But the main part of LB 1124 has to do with a system for valuing agricultural property based upon its value for crop or livestock production. So the point of it...what I'm trying to tell you that I don't intend to bring LB 1124 out here on Final Reading and stick it into LB 419. I believe the issue...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so...

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...is too important for that. But I would like to have this issue...it's still in the same, general area, but it, I think, provides clarification and direction for the property tax administrator and the county assessor how to identify the real estate under farmsteads. It really don't have anything to do specifically with the other area, except for being in the same sections of statute.
