SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And so the only reason you're talking about holding it on Select File is in case the committee has any input on these specific questions that are in this bill?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Yes,...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...if they're...because these will be...this gives me the opportunity, if there's better language...two things, Senator Beutler, better language for the purposes of the definition here. And also, if nothing comes out of committee that contains this language, we still have this available.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Okay?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah, I appreciate that.

SENATOR COORDSEN: I know it's a little bit unusual, but it's the best I could do...

SENATOR BEUTLER: No, I...that's...

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...at the time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...perfectly logical, Senator. Let me...let me ask the financial question. I...if I'm understanding this correctly, and correct me if I'm not, to the extent that this has any shifting effect whatsoever, and it may have some, it may have little, I don't know, but to the extent that it does, I take it that the sole shifting effect is as among property taxpayers...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...within a particular jurisdiction.
