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So, yes, there would be an internal shift. But bear in mind, that in those areas where these are located, the farm site valuation does not change, which is at market value. The personal property does not change, and the agricultural property under this proposal does not change. So it's a relatively small shift, and if there is a...as we all understand the taxes come from the needs of all of local government. So this does not, I think, provide a very definite potential for a reduced property tax payment. Certainly, municipal taxes, villages taxes wouldn't apply. The shift would be so small that I don't think we would measure it. But it's extremely important to some people, some property owners who all of a sudden, particularly in the eastern third of the state who have found that...that particularly vacant farms, because I think we probably have a member of the body that, when they found the valuation change, had their vacant farmstead returned to cropland or pasture, whatever, simply because of the valuation increase several years ago. Small shift, doubt that any of us know the difference. I won't be able to tell the difference, I can...I know that, personally. Now, there was a second part to your question?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator, that was the only question, except I do have a couple other questions, so if you would like to continue on your time,...

SENATOR COORDSEN: Please continue.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...that would be fine. Okay. Looking at page 3 of your amendment, the "except" language, which is new, and I'm sure to reveal a degree of ignorance here, but what the heck. It says that except that land currently in use as a farm site not currently occupied or used for any other nonagricultural purposes shall be valued at the same assessed valuation as the contiguous agricultural land under the same ownership in an agricultural use.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Um-huh.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I assume that, if I'm reading it right, a farm site kind of translates to those areas where there are not fields but, generally speaking, there are out buildings of one type or another, is that...
