SENATOR JANSSEN: Yeah, I'm wondering, though, you know, during the season that the migration is taking...is happening, that the game wardens have...probably have plenty to do the way it is. That would be their busy time of the year, which would be in the fall of the year, when you've got pheasant season, duck season, and now, with deer as plentiful as they are, they're having more seasons with deer. So I would imagine that there...would this...all right. Let me ask you this question, do you know whether this would mean adding additional officers to the...to the Game Commission? Are you aware that they would be putting more...more game wardens on?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Janssen, I don't think this bill has any implications towards whether they would hire more personnel or not. Actually, it probably is not going to change a whole lot what they've been doing, it just allows them to use the Cash Fund rather than for the investigative officer to use their own money and then be reimbursed by Game and Parks.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I understand...

SENATOR SCHROCK: It's more of a procedure type of an issue.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I understand that. I didn't know it was...you know, I didn't know it was that big of a...big of a factor in the state. And I can probably find this information out from someone within the department. But as long as we're discussing this, you know, I want us to be aware that...how...you know, if...if this is an ongoing thing, if...if we're seeing it expanded, if there's more of it happening. I certainly wouldn't think it would have happened this year, because the migration of water fowl, my gosh, didn't start until real late in the year because it was so nice; and I'm not sure it's even started now. You don't see any ducks or geese coming through. But anyway, I...I'm not saying that this isn't a necessary tool that needs to be in place, because I don't believe that those officers should be using their own funds; that's more...that would be more bookwork than this process would be, where they would be able to tap into the Cash Fund. I think it's a good idea, I just need a few more questions answered...
