definition of a bar. And with the help of people who represent that industry, this amendment is offered. So, one of the things that we'll do is clarify that definition, make it clear that bars are not covered by this bill, and it reinstates and clarifies that language in the committee amendment. I consider this a technical amendment. We can have some discussion about it, but this is what it is, and I would just ask that you adopt this amendment with that clarification. And if you have questions, maybe we'll take it up on Select File. But this was done with the bar industry to clarify what's a bar and what's a restaurant. And for purposes of the bill, simply, if you sell more food than you got from entertainment and liquor sales, then you're a restaurant. If vice versa is true, then you're a bar. The other thing it adds is some clarifying language from the Department of Health and Human Services that was proposed for their cleanup bill that inadvertently got left out and it's back in. And so I put it in this bill. So that's clarification language from the department over who's under the Clean Indoor Air Act. Thank you.
