the hearing that that decision should rest with the...with the body of the Legislature and not be made outside of the Secretary of State's...outside of the Legislature, primarily because we are, as all of us recognize, in a transition phase between printed records and records that are maintained electronically. So this, by striking that, I think would retain or we think would retain that particular language. And then the other part of the committee amendments reinserts a stricken portion of 50-114.01 which references a section of law that would be outright...outright repealed that we felt would be better to retain in the statute books at this particular time. With that, is the committee amendment and I would recommend its adoption to LB 534. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Bromm, on the committee amendments.

SENATOR BROMM: I'll waive.
