believe me, I've been there, I've done that. When you come out of that patrol camp, the badge is shiny, you are going to change the world. And I believe this is one of the problems we're having right now with carrier enforcement. We have too many young people there, and after a year or two, they are transferring laterally back over to the Patrol after going through some more schooling, and so I do believe that this maybe needs to be looked at. I think the good may outweigh the bad in that respect, but for whatever it is worth, I am going to support the amendment. I'm going to support the bill, and I will give the remainder of my time to Senator Bromm, if he wants to continue his discussion with Senator Thompson. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, you are just short of two minutes. Senator Bromm, I do not see Senator Bromm. Senator Thompson, you're recognized on the committee amendments to LB 153.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you. I would like to answer Senator Bromm's questions about the appointments from the Patrol, and with the committee amendment, that part was not changed. The committee amendment changes language from that section on, but it reads: The Superintendent of Law Enforcement and Public Safety, two other members of the State Patrol designated by the superintendent. So the superintendent, the executive branch, will have three people that they can bring, if they want to serve themselves and two other troopers who work for them. But we also with another amendment be amending back in the State Troopers' Association so that they also can have a representative at the table. And just for the record, a number of other people, including members of the public and two members of the Legislature, a sheriff or police chief from each of the six trooper sites will be on it. So we will have a broad base of people, including the public, who can come to the table and help work on this issue. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Thompson. Senator Chambers, on the committee amendments to LB 153.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I do support the committee amendments and it is crucial that a review of what the State Patrol is doing be undertaken. My good
