There is some guy who even before Senator Brown got here put my picture next to hers and said she is like me on the death penalty, and she hadn't even been in the Legislature. If she were a friend of mine, do you think I'd do this to her? Why, when I look at Senator Thompson, (laugh) and she can...she can find this, this is going to be transcribed. When I look at Senator Thompson, were I not an old-fashioned man who does not believe in striking women, and were it not for the 8th amendment to the constitution against cruel and unusual punishment where I might tear her head right off her neck. Now when they run their little campaign ads, she can take this direct quote from the transcript, and they'll say, wow, Senator Thompson must have really been doing her job to make old Chambers lose his cool like that on the floor of the Legislature. Now back to the point, I am serious in what I said about Governor Johanns and Sergeant Nesbitt, I mean Colonel Nesbitt. Any attempts to give law enforcement powers to those carrier enforcement people will be fought by me. Now he can call a special session for that like he's going to have to call a special session for a whole lot of things. And he even said in an article that he doesn't mind the inconvenience...
