there's less gambling or there's less money being gambled by whoever. It means that there's less and less of it with the charitable gaming institutions and organizations in Nebraska. Those people that are not gambling in Nebraska are probably going across the river. Pickle card wagering is down about 9.8 percent and in units sold may decrease by 9.4 percent this year. There's been an awful lot of conversation about how we may not expand gambling, but at least encourage those people that do gamble to try to do business in Nebraska. The impact on charitable gaming has been, to say the least, terrible. There are organizations ranging from churches to legion's clubs, and to all the rest of those kinds of organizations that need revenue, not taxes but revenues from this kind of activity, and it's an important problem all across the state. Past out a couple of things. One looks like this and that describes this particular bingo nut game. This actually exists in Massachusetts, but these kinds of games exist all over. Now the only place...we're not changing the gambling laws. The only place that this particular bingo nut game, "pull-card" game, can exist is at already established and licensed bingo parlors in Nebraska. So we're not encouraging any more. We're just trying to do something in the process of that bingo game to make it more interesting. These pickle cards, if you look at the pretty colored picture, I'm not sure which one you got, there's a couple of them out there, does define the instant winners. As you all know, some of you who may have used a pickle card, some of you may never have, but for those of you that have you know that you pull off this card and it indicates whether you won or not. That's called an instant winner. On the one with the two bingo cards, it indicates, for example, the number of...number of takes at 1,980 at 25 cents apiece, how much that takes in, et cetera, et cetera, et cetera. Similar here in Nebraska, it tells you how many winners there are. So you can win instantly, because that's why you buy a tab card generally, but when that game...when that game is sold out, they run that little ball through the machine again at the bingo game and somebody hollers out N-41, and if you've got that bingo card or that tab card that has a B-41 (sic) on it then you have been able to participate in a secondary, not a primary, but a secondary opportunity to win. This, we think, I know because it's worked in so many other states, as we pointed out on our handout to you, might hope to...to encourage people that do insist on
