PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Janssen. The question is the adoption of the committee amendment to LB 477. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Committee amendments are agreed to. Discussion on the advancement of LB 477? Senator Hudkins, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Very quickly, Mr. President, thank you. The bill supports two of the major industries in Nebraska, agriculture and tourism, and for that I would ask your support of the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. The question is the advancement of LB 477 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 477 is advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill is LB 367. It is a bill that was offered by Senator Schimek. (Read title.) The bill was referred...read the first time on January 13 of last year, referred to the Urban Affairs Committee. That committee reports the bill to General File with committee amendments attached. (AM0615, Legislative Journal page 843, First Session, 1999.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. To open on LB 367, Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. This bill has changed since it was introduced and we'll hear about those changes later, but I want to tell you why I brought the cha...or why I brought the bill in the first place.
