PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the eleventh day, the Ninety-Sixth Legislature, Second Session. Our chaplain this morning is the Reverend L. Owen Cervantes from Peru Community Church, in Peru, Nebraska, Senator Vrtiska's district. (Visitors introduced.) Reverend.

REVEREND CERVANTES: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Reverend. Members, if you'll report to the Chamber and record your presence, we'll begin today's business.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections this morning, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: I have received a Reference Report referring LB 1293 through LB 1358 and two resolutions, Mr. President. Hearing notices from Judiciary Committee, signed by Senator Brashear as Chair; and a Report of Registered Lobbyists, as required by statute, who have filed this week.
