This amendment does not help Chip Davis' situation at all. He has had rulings that what he has, as far as the custody and so on, is it; he can't have any more. And if you want to know more about that, we can look up the actual cases for you. But, when he came to the committee, I didn't know he was coming, but he was just a real gentleman and did very nicely and was not overbearing, I didn't feel. I thought he did a very nice job as a witness for the bill. And one of the things he said that, besides musicians, he's not the only musician in the world who has a difficult schedule and varied hours, because they work at night, they work a lot of different times that would not always fit in with the 8:00 to 5:00 schedule that most of us are on. But, besides musicians, farmers and truck drivers, police officers, firefighters; I have a son who drives a truck, the mail, between Lincoln and Omaha every night. He leaves at 7:00, he gets home at 3:00 in the morning. That's very difficult with a family to be on a schedule like that.
